PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete a total of 64 units for both degrees.

Bachelor of Science Requirements:

- ❖ 32 units from Part A and B of the BSc list including:
 - 6 units from Part A (Level 1 courses) including SCIE1000 and STAT1201;
 - 14 units from Part B; and
 - 12 units from Part A or Part B or a combination of both.
- ❖ Students must gain 12 units for late year courses.
- ❖ Students must complete either one major (6 units Level 2 and 8 units late year) or an extended major (10 units Level 2 and 12 units late year).
